As a result, the company considers its new Superlift 3800 the key to being perfectly prepared for the increasingly demanding lifting heights and loads of the future. "For us, the Superlift 3800 is a safe investment in our future, especially as it still has a lot of technical expansion potential," Stefan Schmidbauer points out.

Schmidbauer is planning to use the Superlift 3800 primarily for erecting wind turbines. However, there are also requests for heavy cargo transloading and plant building projects already, meaning that the new unit is guaranteed to be constantly in use.
